Dear Mr. Miner:

This letter authorizes you to report information returns (Forms 1099, 1098, 5498 and W2G) to the IRS on magnetic media as specified on your application. You must prepare your data according to the instructions set forth in the enclosed current applicable Revenue Procedure.

The Transmitter Control Code (TCC) assigned to your organization is 34C37. This number is used to file your information on 3 1/2" or 5 1/4" diskette media only. The five character number (TCC) must be inserted in the Payer/Transmitter "A" record. Follow the instructions and format in the enclosed procedures. This TCC should be used with any correspondence or phone calls to IRS.

Your authorization will be valid as long as the magnetic media submitted conforms to the specifications of the applicable revenue procedures. A new application is not required in following years unless magnetic media filing has been discontinued and you wish to resume it, or the type of magnetic media has changed (e.g. tape to diskette or vice versa).

Your cooperation in this program is appreciated and we look forward to a continued pleasant working relationship.
